Township Board Meeting Minutes

May 9, 2019

The regular meeting of the Cohoctah Township Board was called to order at 8:00 pm with the pledge to the flag. Present: Fosdick, Charette, Torigian, Bock, Fear, ZA/Park Manager Flanary, Rec Rep Clapp, and 3 citizens.

Agenda: Motion by Torigian, support by Charette to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried.

Consent Agenda: Motion by Torigian, support by Bock to approve the Consent Agenda as presented. Motion carried.

Call to the Public- None

Fire Authority – The HAFA Budget was approved at their last meeting. There will be a ribbon cutting ceremony on May 19th at 1pm at the Main Station to present the new addition to the hall.

Rd Commission – Leave on agenda

Hall – The carpet and lighting will be updated in the hall over the summer.

Cemetery – New cemetery software has been installed and data entry has begun.

Parks and Recreation – The first show of the season was cancelled due to wet conditions.

Lloyd Trailer Update- Motion by Torigian, support by Bock to instruct the Township Attorney to file action based on the original representation by Walter Lloyd Jr in December to remove trailer in spring or upon sale of home. Treasurer Bock will follow up with MTA regarding special assessments to claim damages if Township has to remove. Motion carried.

Large Item Day Summary– Large item day was a success. Over 150 residents participated. Motion by Torigian, support by Bock to conduct a second Large Item Day on Saturday, October 5, 2019. Motion carried.

HAFA Fire Prevention Code- The changes to the code were discussed. It has been requested to have a presentation by the Howell Fire Department to give an overview and answer any questions.

PA 116 Request- Motion by Charette, support by Bock to approve the PA 116 application for Huff, including other documents pertinent to the file. Motion carried.

Zoning Board of Appeals- Leave on agenda.

Planning Commission- Charette gave report.

Violations/Complaints – The complaint at 1602 W Cohoctah Rd #C has been resolved. Zoning Administrator Flanary will monitor continued compliance.
