Township Board Meeting Minutes

June 8, 2017

The regular meeting of the Cohoctah Township Board was called to order at 8:00 pm with the pledge to the flag. Present: Fosdick, Buckner, Thurner, Bock, Fear, Z.A. Flanary, State Representative Hank Vaupel, and 4 citizens.

Agenda: Motion by Thurner, support by Buckner to approve agenda as presented. Motion carried.

Minutes: Motion by Thurner, support by Bock to approve May regular Township Board minutes as presented. Motion carried.

Treasurer's report: Motion by Thurner, support by Buckner to receive the May report as presented. Motion carried. Newsletters have been mailed.

First Call to the Public- State Representative Hank Vaupel gave an update on the new budget, Teachers Retirement, road projects, recently passed legislation, and answered questions.

A resident raised concerns regarding the Nazarene Campground Beach expansion. DEQ mailed letters and questions were referred to the DEQ.

Fire Authority - Motion by Bock, support by Fear to accept the Fire Hall Lease Agreement. After discussion regarding Section 5b, 6a, 8 and 10, further clarification has been requested. Bock and Fear withdrew their motion. A review will be made at the July meeting.

Road Commission - Chase Lake Road has been finished. The chloride project has been started.

Hall - Motion by Bock, support by Thurner to purchase a new copier for the Hall not to exceed \$425. Motion carried.

Cemetery - County is looking into the drain issue. The new fence is ready to be installed on the east side.

Parks and Recreation - The first show is being held this weekend. There will be a hot dog vendor. A new pump will be installed for the sprinkler system. Park Manager Flanary is working on bringing new groups to the park.

4th of July Parade- K Thurner reported there will be a Photo Booth at this year's event as well as the pony rides, bounce house, cotton candy and kid's game area. A silent auction will be held to benefit Meals on Wheels.

Reports - ZBA, none. P.C. report given by K. Thurner. Working on Amendment 83. Verizon will be at next meeting for a Public Hearing to complete their application.
